HISTORIC BOOK LAUNCHES 150 YEARS

Millthorpe's long awaited book on the historic homes of Millthorpe and the surrounding district is complete with the launch on Saturday 28 October.

Grants coming from the Blayney Shire Council and the Royal Australian Historical Society have enabled the dedicated committee from the Golden Memories Museum and the Millthorpe Village Committee to complete a valuable resource featuring historic homes and their stories.

Chairman of the publishing committee, John Willing stated that the book features 84 homes with a selection of beautiful photos taken within the past year to match with a selection of older images.

"It is a great story of Millthorpe, the pioneers who built these homes and the present owners who maintain the legacy," said Willing.

To date many of the books are pre-sold with the remaining books available through Jacoba Cottage at The Golden Memories Museum from Sunday 29 October.

The Historic Homes of Millthorpe and District book is also available at gardens 7 and 10 at the Millthorpe Garden Ramble on November 4 and 5, Blayney Library on 9 November, Orange City Library on the evening of 15 November and Millfest on 9 December.

All profits of this initiative will go to the Millthorpe Golden Memories Museum.
